


Framework


- Built upon a framework originally proposed by the Rockefeller Foundation/Construido sobre un marco propuesto originalmente por la Fundación Rockefeller**

- Slight population decline since 2017/Ligera disminución de la población desde 2017


Monterey Bay Area Counties: Population by Race/Ethnicity/

 2017, 2022




Who are we?












Equitable: Core Working Age Labor Force Participation /Reducir La Desigualdad/Participación básica en la fuerza laboral en edad laboral




Equitable: Women's Peace and Security Index by State/Índice de paz y seguridad de las mujeres por estado

Women's Peace and Security Index Ranking by State, 2020/Clasificación del índice de paz y seguridad de las mujeres por estado, 2020







Monterey County General Election 2022









Undocumented Workers by Occupation in Monterey County, 2019/Trabajadores indocumentados por ocupación en el condado de Monterey, 2019






Participatory: Presence in the Market/Presencia en el Mercado Económico









Annual Average Pay, Size, and Growth, 10 Largest Private Industries




Pay Growth, Size, and Average Pay, 10 Largest Private Industries






Monterey County Employment Change, 2017-Q4 2022/Cambio de empleo en el condado de Monterey, 2017-Q4 2022
Annual Average Growth Rate/Tasa media de crecimiento anual




San Benito County County Employment Change, 2017-Q4 2022/Cambio de empleo en el condado de San Benito, 2017-Q4 2022
Annual Average Growth Rate/Tasa media de crecimiento anual




Santa Cruz County Employment Change, 2017-Q4 2022/Cambio de empleo en el condado de Santa Cruz, 2017-Q4 2022
Annual Average Growth Rate/Tasa media de crecimiento anual









Life Expectancy by Tract for Tri-County Region, 2020/ Esperanza de vida por área para la región de los tres condados, 2020

























How are we doing?

Equitable: Income inequality high but stable; improvements in educational outcomes, but stark racial inequalities

Participatory: Eligible voter turnout is low; racial disparities in labor force participation and self-employment income; new business creation up

Growing: GDP per capita and labor productivity up, and rising wages at the low end; high housing cost burden and continued challenges in low-wage industries

Sustainable: Progress in mitigating excessive environmental damage

Stable: Regional economy remains more volatile than the state; challenges for savings and risk mitigation for low-income residents
